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‘Shorn No Bull’ has now arrived at his new paddock!

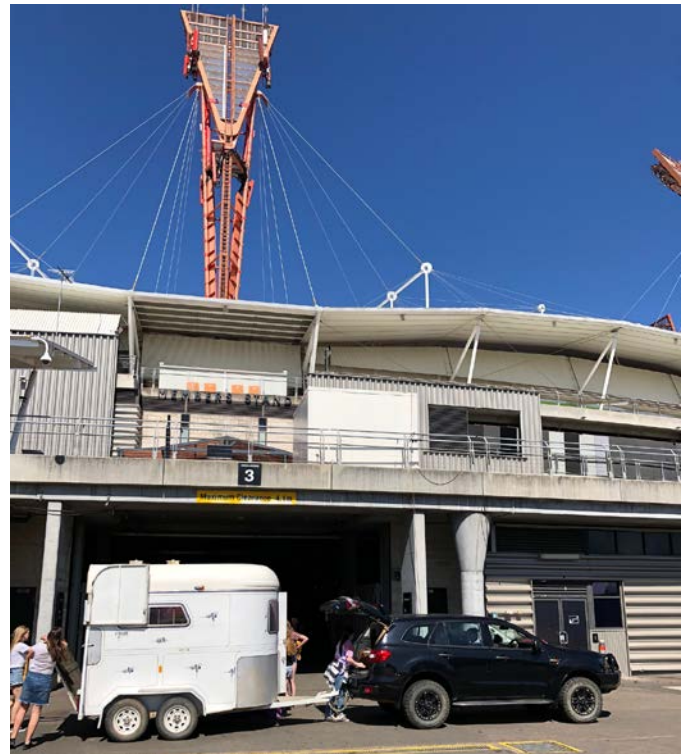
The Archibull Team accompanied by Mary Ventry and Maree Coates transported Shorn No Bull to Sydney Olympic Park on Tuesday 30th October.
